

Call for Abstracts for an EASP-IARR joint Symposium

“What’s Love Got To Do With It: Diversity in Close/Romantic Relationships”

The European Association of Social Psychology (EASP) and the International Association for Relationship Research (IARR) are pleased to invite submissions for a joint virtual symposium, “What’s Love Got To Do With It: Diversity in Close/Romantic Relationships” to be held May 12th 2022.

The virtual symposium seeks to present a state of the art research from both social psychological, relationship studies and interdisciplinary perspectives on diversity topics broadly defined. For example, diversity in close/romantic relationships could be investigated along ethnic, religious and age differences, but also along power dimensions or sexual orientations.

The format will be prerecorded 20 minute talks with live Q & A discussions on May 12th. Submissions may include both published and unpublished work, review and primary data contributions, but in case of primary data must have already been collected and analyzed. Members of either society are eligible to submit.

Abstract Submission Guidelines:

Abstracts should be 300 words or less and be submitted by March 14, 2022.

Abstracts must be written and presented in English. The title should be a concise description of the content (< 25 words). The body of the abstract must be formatted with the following headings: Background, Objective, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

Abstracts will be reviewed, and prospective presenters will be informed regarding acceptance by early April.
